




Through our Transitional Housing program, 82 Veterans have received safe shelter and life-changing services, with over 64% successfully transitioning into permanent housing. At the same time, our Rapid Re-Housing and Homeless Prevention program (SSVF) has

Through our Food Pantry program, the Veterans Integration Centers has provided over 2,200 food boxes this fiscal year alone—reaching Veterans, their families, and community members in times of real need. From emergency housing clients to Veterans in our GPD program, these boxes aren't just about calories—they're about care, stability, and rebuilding lives.

On average, 223 households a month receive essential nutrition thanks to this program. Whether through
